Liang's Bistro, 17515 Bruce B. Downs Blvd., 813-978-1225; Asian. "Thumbing through the entire selections we felt somewhat daunted by the number and variety. . . . At our server's suggestion, we ordered the Sizzling Teriyaki Steak. This was pure beefy butter. The steak finishes cooking at the table in a thick, tangy sauce with sliced mushrooms and onions. Liang's Chicken, thin breaded strips of tender white meat stir-fried with carrots and celery shreds, came coated in a sauce that had a perfect balance of sweet and spicy. The Golden Nest Seafood more than lived up to its name, containing lobster meat, shrimp, crab meat, scallops and a vegetable medley of broccoli, snow peas, water chestnuts and baby corn. The vegetables were perfectly cooked — not too soft — and all the ingredients were cloaked in a delicate cream sauce and nestled in a light, crisp noodle basket. It was a masterpiece of flavor and presentation." Entrees: \$9.95-\$15.95.
